

(For all students in the Program)

Undergraduate Minor Program in Biology

Any non-biology major students under the 3-year degree with an overall CGA of 2.85 or above may enroll in the Biology Minor Program. The students must declare their intention to enroll in the minor program no earlier than the first regular term of their second year but no later than the last day of the add/drop period in the first regular term of their final year of study. Students who wish to withdraw from the minor program should apply before the last day of the add/drop period in the first regular term of their final year of study.

The Biology Minor Program requires a minimum of 18 credits to be taken from the following courses:

Notes:

- (1) Students should take at least one course from the below courses:
LIFS 1010, LIFS 1020, LIFS 1030, LIFS 2060, LIFS 2080
- (2) Students should take at least two courses from the below courses:
LIFS 3030, LIFS 3040, LIFS 3060, LIFS 3130, LIFS 3140, LIFS 3150, LIFS 3160, LIFS 3240
- (3) Student should take at least one course from the below courses:
LIFS 4060, LIFS 4090, LIFS 4140, LIFS 4150, LIFS 4170, LIFS 4360
- (4) Students who do not fulfill the prerequisites need to take LIFS 1010, or get the special approval from the program office. The corequisite will be waived by the program office.

The students are encouraged to develop their interests in different Biology areas.

For credit transfer, students can transfer a maximum total of 6 credits to the Minor Program.

To graduate with a minor in Biology, the students must be enrolled in the minor program and complete all of its requirements, as well as all the requirements of the major program of study; and have attained an average grade point of at least 1.5 in courses taken with the minor program.
