Undergraduate Minor Program in Engineering Management and Law

Any undergraduate students with a CGA of 2.15 or above may enroll in this minor program. They must declare their intention to enroll in the minor program no earlier than the first regular term of their second year of study but no later than the last day of the add/drop period in the first regular term of their final year of study. Students who wish to withdraw from the minor program should apply before the last day of add/drop period in the last regular term of their study.

The Minor Program in Engineering Management and Law requires a minimum of 18 credits to be taken from the following courses:

- (1) Students should take four courses from the following list, with at least 1 course (3 credits) from each group:

Group 1 - Law and Ethics:

CENG 4720, CIVL 4260, ELEC 3710, IELM 2220, IELM 3230, IELM 4170, IELM 4180

For credit transfer, students can transfer a maximum total of 6 credits to the Minor Program.

For students admitted in 2012-13 or after, no more than 9 credits taken to fulfill other requirements may count towards this minor program.

To graduate with a minor in Engineering Management and Law, the students must have enrolled in the minor program and completed all of its requirements, as well as all the requirements of their major program of study.
