Undergraduate Minor Program in Engineering Management and Law

Any undergraduate students with a CGA of 2.15 or above may enroll in this minor program. They must declare their intention to enroll in the minor program no earlier than the first regular term of their second year of study but no later than the last day of the add/drop period in the first regular term of their final year of study. Students who wish to withdraw from the minor program should apply before the last day of add/drop period in the last regular term of their study.

Minor Requirements

To graduate with a minor in Engineering Management and Law, the students must have enrolled in the minor program and completed a minimum total of 18 credits and all of its requirements, as well as all the requirements of their major program of study.

For credit transfer, students can transfer a maximum total of 6 credits to the Minor Program.

For students admitted in 2012-13 or after, at least 9 credits out of the total credits required by the minor program should be single-counted within the minor and are not used to fulfill any other requirements for graduation except the 120-credit degree requirement.
